NEW CITY-WIDE SECURITY GATE LAW

GOES INTO EFFECT JULY 1, 2011

Dear Business or Property Owner,

As you may already know, the City of New York passed a law banning the installation of solid-panel roll down security gates for commercial stores. Existing security gates that are not opengrille will need to be replaced with open-grille gates by 2026.

The Myrtle Avenue BID is sending you this notice to ensure you are aware that if you install a new security gate, it **MUST** be open-grille. If you install a solid-panel security gate, the city can impose a \$1,000 fine.

If you would like to replace your gate to become compliant with the new law, contact the BID for assistance.

FUNDING AVAILABLE TO HELP PAY FOR NEW SECURITY GATES

The Myrtle Ave Brooklyn BID can **reimburse** business and property owners for 50% of the cost of a new open-grille roll-down gate, up to \$1,000. This money is a **grant** and does not need to be paid back. Grants for new signage are also available.



To be eligible for a grant, businesses and properties must be located within the Myrtle Ave BID (Myrtle Ave between Flatbush & Classon Avenues).

After July 1st, all new roll-down security gates must be at least 70% open-grille
